### CAPE FEAR TRANSPORTATION 2040 OPEN HOUSES

The draft **Cape Fear Transportation 2040** Plan will be available for public review and comment from April 1, 2015 to April 30, 2015. This draft metropolitan transportation plan looks 25 years into the future to address a broad spectrum of federal transportation requirements for the Wilmington MPO planning area. The planning area includes all of New Hanover County and portions of Brunswick and Pender Counties. The plan includes an examination and evaluation of potential roadway, freight/rail, mass transportation, ferry and water transportation, aviation, bicycle and pedestrian projects.

The **Cape Fear Transportation 2040** Plan will continue to be developed through broad public outreach. Between April 1<sup>st</sup> and April 30<sup>th</sup>, residents of the Cape Fear region will be able to offer their comments on the new draft plan by visiting one of seven regional open houses (or by visiting the plan's website at <http://Transportation2040.org>):
