



## The Duke Energy Educational Pavilion

The Town of Belville, with a \$55,000 grant from Duke Energy, is constructing a riverfront educational facility to benefit Brunswick County students. The facility will provide for a “hands-on, living laboratory” as opposed to sole reliance on textbooks, for the study and completion of the NCK-12 Core Curricula. All classes conducted on site will be available for broadcast, live, over the schools network to allow visual and verbal real-time interaction by all 12,200 students within the network. The Town of Belville is funding and clearing the land, erecting the overwater observation deck and riverfront boardwalks. The NC Departments of Fish and Wildlife, Inland Marine Fisheries, Wildlife Commission and Environmental Protection are providing the educational software tools and some exhibits.

“Education Angels” are needed to provide sorely needed components to enhance and facilitate the students’ experiences and abilities. All “Education Angels”, who contribute \$200 or more, will be recognized by a permanent 3”x5” brass plaque prominently mounted and displayed on the classroom wall.



Examples of items needed are:

Experiment and education workbenches; 8 at \$800 each

Bird and Bat houses: 6 at \$50 each

Test tubes, vials and papers: 24 boxes at \$50 each

Signage identifying flora and fauna: 75 at \$30 each

Field worksite benches: 6 at \$125 each

Microscopes and plates: 8 at \$250 each

Dry Erase chalkboard: 1 at \$225
