Brunswick County Sheriff's Office

I joined the Brunswick County Sheriff's Office in 1991 as a Patrol Deputy under Sheriff John Carr Davis and worked my way through the ranks with the Warrant Division, Detective Division and Narcotics Division. I was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant of the Narcotic's Division in 1999. I was also the SWAT Team Commander from 1998-2004 in which I received hundreds of hours of tactical training.

As Lieutenant in the Narcotics Division I was responsible for the supervision of seven narcotic agents. During my tenure as Lieutenant, these agents and I conducted thousands of illegal drug investigations, which resulted in hundreds of arrest and convictions. In 2004, I voluntarily resigned from the Brunswick County Sheriff's Office.

Shortly after leaving the Brunswick County Sheriff's Office in 2004, I was hired as a Lieutenant in charge of the Narcotics Division by Sheriff Chris Batten (Columbus County Sheriff). In 2006, I was promoted to the rank of Chief Deputy. In this capacity I oversaw the day to day operations of the Columbus County Sheriff's Office and also prepared the annual operating budget as well as overseeing the construction of the new detention facility. I left the Columbus County Sheriff's Office in 2007 to come back and help with my family business.

On April 7th, 2008, acting Sheriff Greg White appointed me as Chief Deputy of the Brunswick County Sheriff's office. On May 19th, 2008 I was sworn in as Sheriff of Brunswick County. I will finish this two year term as Sheriff and in 2010 I plan to run for Office of Sheriff for Brunswick County.
