Closure of Blackwell Road in Brunswick County postponed to October 4

WILMINGTON--The closure of Blackwell Road in Brunswick County has been postponed one week due to inclement weather. All lanes will now be closed on Blackwell Road between U.S. 17 and N.C. 133, from 7 a.m., Saturday, Oct. 4, through 6 a.m., Monday, Oct. 6, weather permitting.

Crews from the [N.C. Department of Transportation](#) will be installing a drain pipe and waterline for the Blackwell Road relocation as part of the Causeway Bridge Project.

Local traffic will be able to access Blackwell Road from U.S. 17, however, there will be **NO** access at N.C. 133.
