Closure of Blackwell Road in Brunswick County postponed due to Utility Issues

Wilmington--The closure of Blackwell Road between U.S. 17 and N.C. 133 in Brunswick County has been postponed due to utility issues.

Once those issues are resolved, Blackwell Road will be closed as originally scheduled. Crews from the [N.C. Department of Transportation](#) will be installing a drain pipe and waterline for the Blackwell Road relocation as part of the Causeway Bridge Project.

Local traffic will be able to access Blackwell Road from U.S. 17, however, there will be no access at N.C.133.
