BELVILLE HOSTS GRAND OPENING OF DUKE ENERGY EDUCATION PAVILION

MARCH 25, 2015 – A grand opening celebration, complete with a ribbon-cutting ceremony, is slated for the Duke Energy Education Pavilion at the Brunswick Riverwalk at Belville, located at 580 River Road in Belville, NC from 2:00 to 3:00pm on Saturday, March 28th. The ceremony is free and open to the public.

“Our dream of having a park that everyone in the region can enjoy has become a reality,” said Mayor Mike Allen. “We would like to invite the residents of our community to the ceremony to help celebrate the long-awaited opening of the education pavilion.

Representatives from Duke Energy are expected to attend the grand opening and will participate in the formal ribbon-cutting ceremony. A host of state and local officials will also be present to express their support for the completion of the project.

Funding for Phase I of the Brunswick Riverwalk Project was obtained from grants provided by Duke Energy and the North Carolina Parks and Recreation Trust Fund. The education pavilion, to be utilized by the students of Brunswick County, is the first part of the project to be completed. Future projects included in Phase I include a 125-foot fishing pier, woodland trails and a riverfront boardwalk.
