TOWN OF BELVILLE PREPARES FOR TROPICAL STORM ANA

TOWN OF BELVILLE – The National Hurricane Center upgraded the weather advisory for the Southeastern Coast of North Carolina, including the Town of Belville, to a Tropical Storm Warning. There is a strong possibility that the Town of Belville will receive some effects of Tropical Storm Ana, if it continues on the same path and speed as it is now traveling.

Mayor Mike Allen and the Belville Board of Commissioners request that all residents, property owners and boating interests begin to make preparations in securing their property.

Town officials are in constant contact with emergency management officials and the weather service and will provide ample warning and time to evacuate, should it become necessary.

The Brunswick Riverwalk at Belville will be closed on Sunday, May 10, 2015 due to the storm.
