TOWN OF BELVILLE: There has been a misunderstanding about a line in yesterday's press release. The sentence, "Levels of GenX and other contaminants have been severely under reported," was not meant to infer that local water utilities are withholding test results from their customers.

Instead, it was meant to state our concern about the lack of information that has been relayed to the public over the years about the contaminants being found in the Cape Fear River.

Yesterday, we learned tests are underway to gather data on Nafion 1 and 2, contaminants where there is little known about their health effects. As the StarNews reported, its levels in the Cape Fear River do not appear to be dropping.

We hope this clears up the confusion.
