The State Asbestos Hazard Management Branch **MUST BE NOTIFIED** of plans to demolish or move **ANY BUILDING** at least 10 working days **BEFORE** the demolition or moving is to begin, whether or not the building is known to contain asbestos. Please contact their office at (919)707-5950.

The following provisions shall govern the removal:

1. Demolition work having commenced shall be pursued diligently and without unreasonable interruption with due regard to safety. It is the intent of this agreement to limit the existence of an unsafe condition or nuisance on the premises during the period of demolition operations.
2. Any surface holes or irregularities, wells, septic tanks, basements, cellars, sidewalk vaults, or coal chutes remaining after demolition or moving of any building or structure shall be filled with materials as approved by the Building Official and shall be graded in such manner that will provide effective surface drainage.
3. All debris and accumulation of material resulting from demolition of any building or structure shall be removed from the premises after demolition is complete.
4. All building sewers shall be effectively plugged with concrete at the property line, or as may be required by the Building Official.
5. All chimneys, steps, foundations above the ground level, sheds, porches, etc., which are attached to a building and are considered a part of the building are to be demolished or removed with the building.
6. Applicant is responsible for making any necessary arrangements with utility companies for the disconnection of service and the removal of and recovery by them of any electric meters, gas meters, or telephones.

- 7. Brunswick Regional Water & Sewer (H2GO) must be notified to disconnect any water and sewer lines.
- 8. Sidewalks, walkways, or streets should be barricaded if public safety is at risk.
- 9. Debris and all other obstructions on sidewalks and streets shall be immediately cleared and left in as good a condition as it was before such work was commenced.
