WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY

In consideration of being allowed to participate as a volunteer (“Volunteer”) providing services (“Services”) to the Town of Belville (“Town”) during its Founders’ Day event (the “Event”), the undersigned hereby:

1. Agrees that prior to providing any Services, he/she shall inspect the Event’s location and if they believe anything to be unsafe, shall immediately notify a member of the Town’s staff of such condition and refuse to provide any Services until the condition has been sufficiently addressed by the Town.

2. Acknowledges that he/she is providing the Services for their own personal benefit, in support of the Event’s goals, and is aware of and understands the potential risks associated with providing Services including possible property damage, personal injury, death, and other risks unknown to and unforeseeable by the Town. Being so informed, the undersigned assumes personal responsibility for all risks, injuries, and damages whatsoever, known and unknown, to themselves and their property in connection with providing the Services and that the Services are being provided voluntarily and upon an informed basis.

3. Holds harmless, releases, waives, discharges from all claims, damages, and liability whatsoever, and covenants not to sue the Town, its elected officials, Town Administrator, employees, representatives, agents, and assigns and the sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and vendors associated with the Event.

4. Agrees that this Waiver and Release of Liability represents the entire agreement between the undersigned Volunteer and the Town pertaining to the undersigned’s provision of Services at the Event.

I HAVE READ THE FORGOING WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, UNDERSTAND THAT I AM GIVING UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING THE SAME, AND AM SIGNING THE SAME VOLUNTARILY AND UPON AN INFORMED BASIS.
