Planning Consultants for the Town of Belville are conducting a Stormwater Feasibility Study and are beginning the public engagement period. The study was funded by a grant from NC Department of Environmental Quality Division of Water Resources.

The Town of Belville is inviting its residents to participate from Tuesday, May 28 – Tuesday, June 11 in the development of the Town's Stormwater Feasibility Study. The Town is working with WithersRavenel who is conducting surveys and modeling where the stormwater and flooding issues exist in our town. Now is the time to give **your** input, and let us know about your drainage and stormwater areas of concern. We are asking residents to pinpoint these areas, so they can be added to the report.
