## Things to Know



#### Christmas Tree Recycling

Live Christmas trees are free to recycle at the Brunswick County Landfill, located at 172 Landfill Road NE, Bolivia until Jan. 31, 2025. The landfill is open from 7:30 a.m.-5 p.m. Monday-Friday and from 7:30 a.m.-3 p.m. on Saturdays. Christmas trees can also be taken to one of four convenience sites located throughout the county for a fee of \$5 per tree:

- Leland Convenience Center, 9921 Chappell Loop Road SE, Leland.
- Southport Convenience Center, 8392 River Road SE, Southport.
- Sunset Beach Convenience Center, 746 Seaside Road SW, Sunset Beach.

• Supply Convenience Center, 1709 Open Road SW, Supply.

All four locations are open from 8 a.m.-6 p.m. Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday.

During this cold weather, brush up on some tips to to keep your family, pets, and home safe and comfortable in winter. Check out some of these tips from Brunswick County and the NOAA


#### **Upcoming Events**

#### Highway 133 Closure

<u>HWY 133 is closed</u> until September 2025 according to the NCDOT. The roadway is closed between Funston Road SE and Dora's Way SE, just south of Olde Town and northeast of Boiling Spring Lakes. Make alternative travel plans if your commute takes you through this area. Posted detour signs will route drivers to NC 87 and US 17.


