



## PROCLAMATION STATE OF EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, the Belville Board of Commissioners has duly adopted ordinances pursuant to the provisions of N.C.G.S § 14-288.12 to determine and proclaim the existence of a State of Emergency and to impose certain prohibitions and restrictions appropriate to meet the emergency;

**WHEREAS**, Governor Josh Stein has proclaimed a State of Emergency on January 29th in the State of North Carolina, and advised residents to prepare for the winter storm which may bring snow and freezing temperatures to all of North Carolina.

**NOW THEREFORE**, Mayor Charles Bost, representing the Belville Board of Commissioners, hereby proclaims that:

### I

A Weather Briefing for North Carolina indicates that Winter storm Gianna, has the potential to bring a variety of weather impacts including snow and freezing temperatures, which may accumulate in Southeastern North Carolina, including Belville. In anticipation of those weather events, the Town of Belville has declared a State of Emergency. The prohibitions set forth herein are necessary to protect the health and safety in our town in a time of emergency.

### II

The proclamation of a State of Emergency will be effective, Friday, January 30, 2026 at 5:00 p.m., and shall remain in effect until rescinded by the Mayor and/or Board of Commissioners.
