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Town of Belville Statement Regarding Potential Development of Downtown Property

BELVILLE, NC – Belville's downtown development continues to be a high priority for the Town. The 18 years of stalled development and extensive litigation have caused unwanted and unforeseen delays, but the recent placement of the downtown property for sale by the largest property owner has garnered renewed interest by development groups. The Town has had several substantial conversations and meetings and they have been very encouraging and positive.

“There is still much work to be done before we can move into the next phase, but we are optimistic that this is a significant turning point for the downtown revitalization. I am very excited at this turn of events,” Mayor Chuck Bost said. “We have talked for so long about developing the downtown and nothing came to fruition. In fact, it sometimes felt we would never be able to make progress to build a downtown in Belville. But I think, for the first time in a long time, we are moving the ball! We will continue to work hard on our downtown and will provide updates as they become available.”
